**ORDER GRANTING
SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE ESTATE AT PRIVATE SALE FREE AND
CLEAR OF ALL CLAIMS, LIENS, AND ENCUMBRANCES AND AUTHORIZING
RETURN OF BRIGADE CAPITAL DEPOSIT [ECF NO. 355]**

THIS MATTER came before the Court at a hearing on May 7, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. upon Trustee's *Motion For Entry Of Order Authorizing Trustee To: (I) Sell Personal Property Of The Estate At Private Sale Free And Clear Of All Claims, Liens, And Encumbrances; And (II) Return Brigade Capital Deposit* (the "**Motion**") (ECF No. 355). The Court having reviewed the Motion

and the record in this case, having noted no objections were made by any interested party, finding that good and sufficient cause exists to granting the relief sought in the Motion and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, does hereby

ORDER as follows:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED**.
2. The Court approves the sale of the estate's interest in the trademarks and domain names listed on Schedule 1 (the "**Assets**") to the Asset Purchase Agreement ("**APA**") in Exhibit "A" of the Motion, to Gangnam, Inc. ("**Buyer**") for the purchase price of \$50,000.00 free and clear of all liens, claims, and encumbrances. The Trustee is authorized to execute all documents reasonably necessary to effectuate the conveyance of the Assets to Buyer.
3. Upon receipt of the sale proceeds from Buyer, the Trustee is authorized to return the good faith deposit funded by Brigade Capital in the amount of \$15,000 to Brigade Capital.
4. The fourteen (14) day stay period detailed in Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(h) shall not apply to the sale approved by the Court in this Order and this Order shall be effective immediately upon entry by the Court.
